Historia/History:

- In 1895, Arthur Atwater Kent founded the Kent Electric Manufacturing Co. in the back room of his father's machine shop. He designed, made, and sold small electric motors and fans.
- In 1902, the Atwater Kent Mfg. Works were founded in Philadelphia, which later, in 1919, became the Atwater Kent Manufacturing Company.
- In 1921, Kent started to engage in radio, producing Bakelite variocouplers, RF and audio transformers. In 1922, he offered the first breadboard radio series, the 39xx types. These radios, when one of their variocouplers was added, became a regenerative radio, but this idea, patented by Armstrong, was the responsibility of the user and without Kent's responsibility.
- Atwater Kent radios <u>are treasures for today's collectors</u>.
