História / History:

1- 1920, the Jewett Phonograph Company was first incorporated in June by Harry M. Jewett, Edward H. Jewett and Frederick L. Jewett capitalized at \$250,000. Edward H. Jewett was President. Initially, he company made phonographs but later started to manufacture radio phonographs.

2- 1922, the company changed it's name to the Jewett Radio & Phonograph Company with plans to expand the production to build monthly 1,000 phonographs of all types, 100 radio-phonographs, 1,000 regenerative receivers and 1,000 radio-frequency sets.

3- 1925, the company was still producing radios and speakers.
